### Paul Writes About His Conversion

- I. **WRITING TO THE CHURCH IN CORINTH...**
  - A. He was called to be an apostle - **1 Cor. 1:1**
  - B. He had seen Jesus Christ - **1 Cor. 9:1**
  - C. His testimony joined that of the others who had seen Him - **1 Cor. 15:7-8**
- II. **WRITING TO THE CHURCHES IN GALATIA...**
  - A. He was an apostle by Jesus Christ, not men - **Gal. 1:1**
  - B. His conversion was the result of a special calling - **Gal. 1:15-16**
    1. Part of God's plan for him even before his birth
    2. When called, it was by the grace of God - cf. **1 Cor. 15:10**
    3. To reveal His Son to him, that he might preach Him among the nations
- III. **WRITING TO THE CHURCH IN ROME...**
  - A. Called to be an apostle, separated unto the gospel of God - **Rom. 1:1**
  - B. Having received both grace and his apostleship - **Rom. 1:5**
  - C. Delivered from the bondage of sin to freedom in Christ - **Rom. 7:7-8:2**
- IV. **WRITING TO THE CHURCH IN EPHEBUS...**
  - A. By grace and special revelation he came to know the mystery of Christ - **Eph. 3:1-6**
  - B. By grace he received his ministry to preach the riches of Christ - **Eph. 3:7-8**
- V. **WRITING TO THE CHURCH IN PHILIPPI...**
  - A. He spoke of being "apprehended (laid hold) of Jesus Christ" - **Phil. 3:10-12**
  - B. A possible reference to his conversion on the road to Damascus
- VI. **WRITING TO TIMOTHY...**
  - A. Thankful that Christ put him into the ministry - **1 Tim. 1:12**
  - B. Acknowledged that it was due to mercy and grace, for he was the chief of sinners - **1 Tim. 1:13-16**

### CONCLUSION

Paul's conversion had a great impact on the early church...

- A. prompted them to glorify God in him - **Gal. 1:22-24**
- B. proved a powerful testimony to the resurrection of Jesus
