# The Inspiration of the Bible

## God has not been and is not silent

**Isaiah 46:6-7** They lavish gold out of the bag,  
And weigh silver on the scales; They hire a  
goldsmith, and he makes it a god; They  
prostrate themselves, yes, they worship. <sup>7</sup>They  
bear it on the shoulder, they carry it And set it  
in its place, and it stands; From its place it shall  
not move. Though one cries out to it, yet it  
cannot answer Nor save him out of his trouble.

# The Inspiration of the Bible

**2 Peter 1:16-21** For we did not follow cunningly devised fables when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of His majesty. <sup>17</sup>For He received from God the Father honor and glory when such a voice came to Him from the Excellent Glory: "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." <sup>18</sup>And we heard this voice which came from heaven when we were with Him on the holy mountain. <sup>19</sup>And so we have the prophetic word confirmed, which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts; <sup>20</sup>knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation, <sup>21</sup>for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

# Our Duty Towards the Bible

## 1. Obey it

**1 Peter 1:22 – 2:3** Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart, <sup>23</sup>having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever, <sup>24</sup>because "All flesh is as grass, And all the glory of man as the flower of the grass. The grass withers, And its flower falls away, <sup>25</sup>But the word of the LORD endures forever." Now this is the word which by the gospel was preached to you.



# Our Duty Towards the Bible

## 1. Obey it

**1 Peter 1:22 – 2:3 (cont.)** <sup>2:1</sup>Therefore, laying aside all malice, all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking, <sup>2</sup>as newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby, <sup>3</sup>if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is gracious.

**Romans 10:17** *So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.*

# Our Duty Towards the Bible

## 1. Obey it

**2 Peter 1:2-4** *Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, <sup>3</sup>as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, <sup>4</sup>by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.*



# Our Duty Towards the Bible

**Acts 17:11** *These were more fair-minded than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so.*

**2 Timothy 2:15** *Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.*

**2 Peter 1:20** *knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation,*



# Our Duty Towards the Bible

**Revelation 22:18-19** *For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book; and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.*
